



Each year, Michigan American Council on Education (MI-ACE) Women's Network hosts an annual conference to support the leadership development of women in higher education. Women-identified educators are encouraged to attend the conference, as research continues to indicate women remain underpaid, lack access to opportunities which propel career advancement, and are less likely to receive adequate mentorship in U.S. higher education. The annual MI-ACE conference offers an enriched network, in addition to opportunities to strategize and explore promising practice. At the 2024 annual conference, we were elated to note Dr. Amy McGinnis' acceptance of the MI-ACE Woman of Distinction Award. In nominating Amy for this distinction, President Davies stated, "Dr. McGinnis has mentored dozens of our students in a research capacity, encouraging them to develop their passion for research...We believe she has distinguished herself as a mentor and leader of and for women in higher education."
